

## The town hall

The first autonomous headquarters of the municipality of San Pellegrino Terme, which until then had been housed in various private buildings in combination with primary school classrooms, was established in 1890.

In 1906, in the fervour of the Belle Epoque, the architect Romolo Squadrelli, who had designed the Grand Hotel and the Casino, realised a project to extend the existing small building with 15th-century style façade architecture, with mullioned and three-mullioned windows and interior decoration of the wooden ceilings, of which only one specimen is preserved on the ground floor.

In 1930/1932, engineer Luigi Angelini planned a renovation of both the façades and the interior in neo-Renaissance style, carried out by Impresa Gherardi under the direction of engineer Savoldelli and with decorations by Studio artistico Fasciotti.

In 2007, the project to restore the architectural structures, stuccoes and decorations was carried out.
