The bridge was built to a design by engineer Michele Astori and was inaugurated in 1924. This bridge replaced the wooden one, which was inadequate to connect the Grand Hotel to the Fonte and the Casino. Of the old bridge, the remains of the posts driven into the riverbed are still visible underwater.

By resolution of the Municipal Council of 23 July 1923, the bridge was dedicated to Prince Umberto. An artistic parchment was made for the occasion and delivered into the Prince's hands by Minister Bortolo Belotti.

At the entrance of the bridge, note the characteristic decorative concrete piers designed by arch. Antonio Cavallazzi and also located in other areas of the municipal territory, such as at the entrance of the park of the spring.
