

San Pellegrino - Vetta Funicular Terms and conditions of travel - Welcome on board Valid from 15th July 2022

1) Travel documents

Passengers travelling by San Pellegrino - Vetta funicular must make sure they have the valid travel document and to keep it for the duration of their journey.

Travel documents must be purchased before boarding. Round-trip tickets must be validated in order to unlock the turnstiles.

Passengers whose ticket has expired must stamp another in order to finish their journey or to take a new ride. Round-trip tickets must be used during **the same day of validation**, are personal and non-transferable.

2) Pushchairs and prams

For safety reasons, only one small pram or one pushchair with a child is allowed to travel by the funicular. It has to be placed in the dedicated area and the lock mechanism must be in place.

Adults are responsible and must supervise during the journey.

In the event of a passenger in a wheelchair being on board or boarding, the pram must be folded.

3) Accessibility

Passengers in wheelchairs, even without career and with motor wheelchairs not exceeding kg 150 full load, may use the funicular. Access must be carried out with the assistance of the driver using the proper lift and the on-board safety devices. For safety reasons, only one wheelchair per funicular is allowed.

Passengers with disabilities and pregnant women have priority access to the funicular with the related companions and minors.

Passengers in wheelchairs travel for free.

4) Travelling with pets

By the funicular may travel:

- all dog sizes only with leash, muzzle and ticket;
- other animals if transported in proper boxes or bags not exceeding cm 50x30x30 in size

Passengers with pets must ensure:

- to purchase a travel document for the animal (fares are the same as those of other passengers);
- that pets do not get on seats, dirty or spoil the vehicle or cause damage to other passengers.

Guide and rescue dogs are allowed to travel for free, without muzzle or leash. If the funicular is crowded the driver can forbid the access to any kind of animal.

5) Carriage of items

Passengers can travel with a luggage not exceeding cm 20x40x60 or a small musical instrument included in the ticket. Passengers must pay a ticket for any piece of luggage up to cm 40x80x120 or for more pieces of the size allowed, including folding bikes, scooters and other electric micro-mobility devices. The passenger must arrange objects so that they do not constitute a hindrance or danger, even in case of sudden braking



of the vehicle. The passenger is in any case responsible for any damage caused by persons or things, due to their transport.

It is forbidden to transport objects exceeding cm 40x80x120, weapons, inflammables, explosives, foul-smelling or dangerous items.

6) Bicycles

It is forbidden to carry bicycles is forbidden.

7) Conduct on board

Passengers travelling by San Pellegrino - Vetta funicular must:

- not force the turnstiles to open while waiting for the car in order to avoid the system block;
- not lean out of the windows while the funicular is moving;
- use the safety handles, even when seated;
- follow the instructions of the personnel on duty in the event of a block of the funicular;
- behave politely and respectfully, do not disturb other passengers or the personnel on duty and not damage devices on board;
- give the seat to people with disabilities, elderly people or pregnant women;
- not activate emergency devices if not necessary;
- comply with the safety and operating regulations communicated by the personnel on duty;
- not eat or drink on board;
- keep the volume on mobiles and audio devices low and don't speak loud.

Failure to comply with the provisions of points a), b), c), d), g), h) of this article and those related to article 2 "Pushchairs and prams" exonerate ATB from any liability in the event of any injury to the passenger during their journey.

8) No smoking

Smoking at the stations and on board, even electronic cigarettes, is forbidden.

9) Photographs and videos

Photographs and videos are allowed only in the course of a purely personal or household activity. (art. 2 clause c GDPR)
